BioPharmica investee granted NZ patent

Cortical Dynamics, an investee company of BioPharmica Ltd, was granted a patent for the 'Method of monitoring brain function'

541615 in New Zealand.

Cortical Dynamics is developing an anaesthesia monitoring system for use during major surgery. The technology is based on real time analysis of the patients' electroencephalogram (EEG) using algorithm and physiologically detailed understanding of the brain's rhythmic electrical activity.

The theory was developed by Professor David Liley, who heads the scientific team at Cortical Dynamics at Swinburne University of Technology, Melbourne.

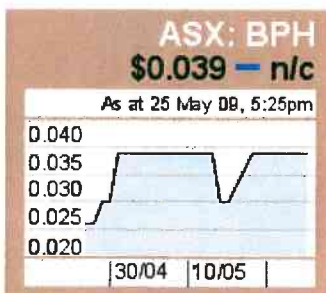
